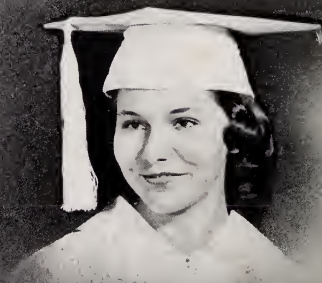
We hope that you will enjoy re-living these memories with us as much as we have enjoyed weaving them for you.

# HOME ECONOMICS

For the first time in many years, home economics is being offered in Biscoe High School.

Thirty-eight girls, sophomores, juniors, and seniors are learning something of the seven areas of homemaking: child development, foods and nutrition, housing, family relations, health and safety, home care of the sick, clothing and grooming.
