



Twelve stellar students gave papers at the annual Alpha Chi convention in Little Rock, Arkansas, the week before Easter break. The 12 students who represented GWU were Brittany Bounds, Anna Bozovich, Elizabeth Cashwell, Sarah Chapman, Anna Johnson, Tyler McCall, Nikki Raye Rice, Samantha Riebold, Claire Saunders, Carrie Sippy, Collyn Warner, and James Withrow.

In addition to giving wonderful papers and performances, the GWU Alpha Chi members were distinguished in other ways: Elizabeth Cashwell and Anna Johnson won presentation prizes. Out of the 400 students at the conference, only about 20 won these \$200 prizes. Carrie Sippy was a runner up for a prestigious national Benedict Fellowship. Collyn Warner won the Region III scholarship for her essay on Islamic feminism. Nikki Raye Rice was elected one of seven regional student delegates to the national Alpha Chi governing board.

GWU Alpha Chi members also took part in a literacy project that collected 1,250 books at the conference and 1,500 books before the conference to distribute to children at a hospital in Little Rock. They also raised \$2,500 for Heifer International, which is located in Little Rock.



Words cannot begin to express our appreciation for the scholarship you provided to Gardner-Webb University for our mission trip to New Mexico, March 12-19, 2010. We had the privilege of working with Living Spring Church which is a Navajo Church in Counselor, NM.

This trip was a life-changing experience for our students in many ways. First of all, it was humbling to see the poor conditions in which many of the Navajos live. Some do not have electricity or running water. Others have no roofing (other than a dirt floor) in their home. It was almost as if once we got off of the highway and turned on the dirt road for the 15 minute drive to the church, we had entered a third-world country. Another way in which our students were impacted was by witnessing the gratitude of the Navajo people for our ministry to them. What may have seemed very little to us was enormously appreciated by them.

As we led worship that last night in the Navajo church, as expected, we got a glimpse of heaven. The first song we sang was "Victory in Jesus." Our team sang in English and the rest of the church sang in Navajo. I'm convinced this was just a taste of what heaven will be like when people from every tribe and every nation bow before the throne of God to sing praises to Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.

# Football

Like most seasons, the 2009 season featured both highs (convincing wins, post-season awards) and lows (frustrating defeats, injuries). But through it all, the players and staff gave GWU fans a reason to come out to the games and cheer on the Runnin' Bulldogs.

A few highlights from the 2009 season include a decisive 58-14 win over Mars Hill to open the season and the thrill of playing in front of 50,000 fans at N.C. State (despite losing to the Wolfpack). The Bulldogs also opened conference play with victories over Big South opponents VMI and Charleston Southern, and capped the season with a 21-14 road victory over Presbyterian.

With the return of numerous all-conference award-winners (senior offensive lineman Corey O'Daniel, senior linebacker Marty Patterson, senior running back Patrick Hall, junior wide receiver James Perry III, junior kicker Ryan Gates, and Matt Goods), a strong leadership presence by our senior class, and the addition of 22 members of a very talented recruiting class, Bulldog Football will field a hard-working and competitive team in 2010.








# Cheerleading
