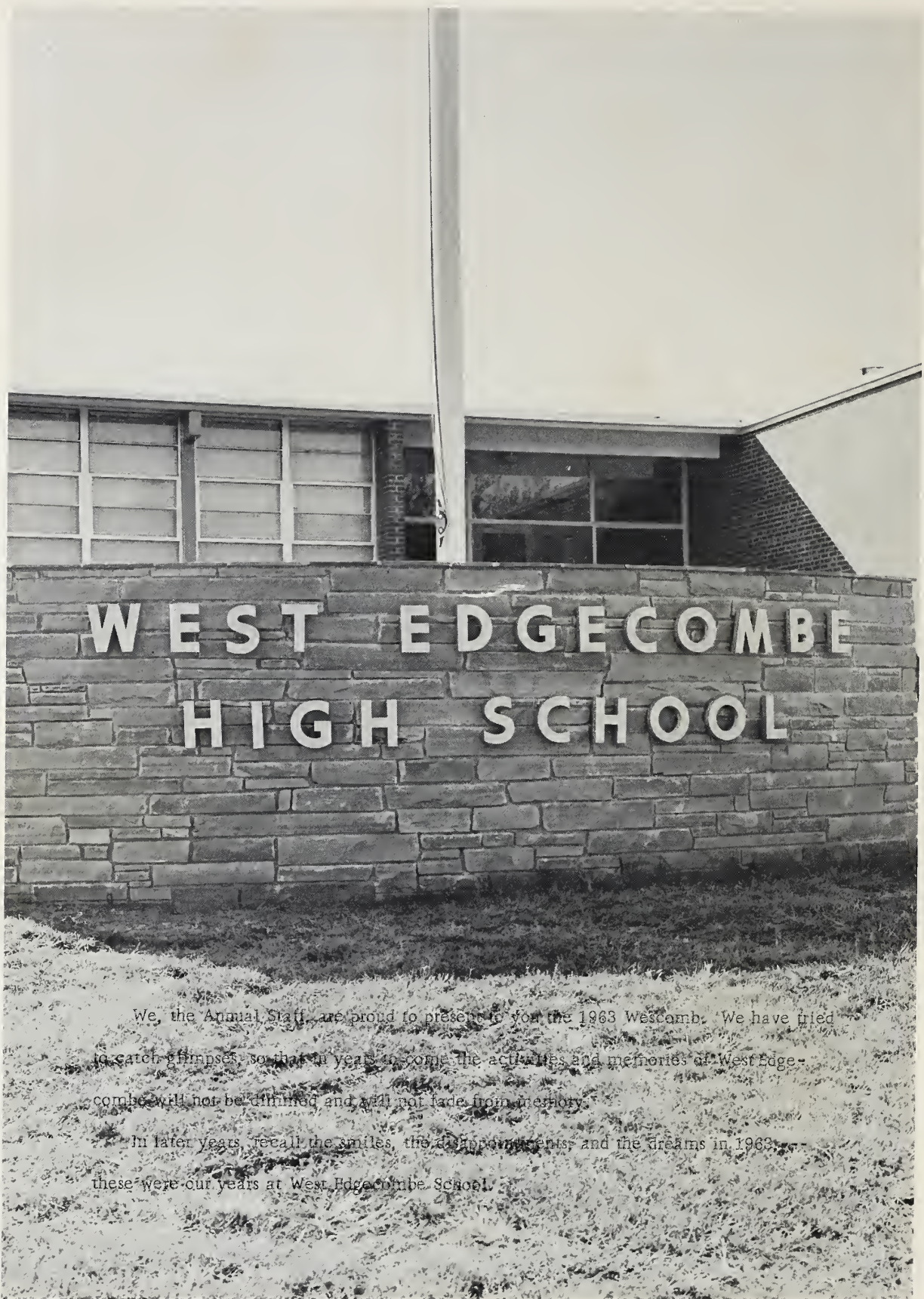

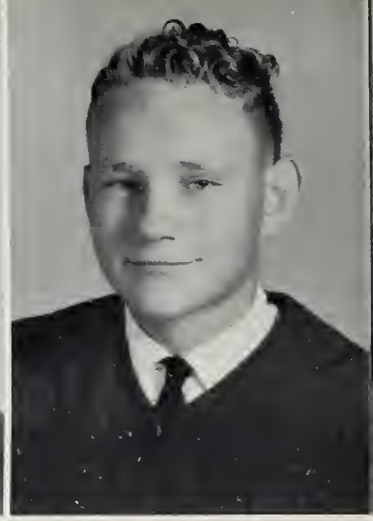
“Happy Days Are Here”

“Just One More Chance”

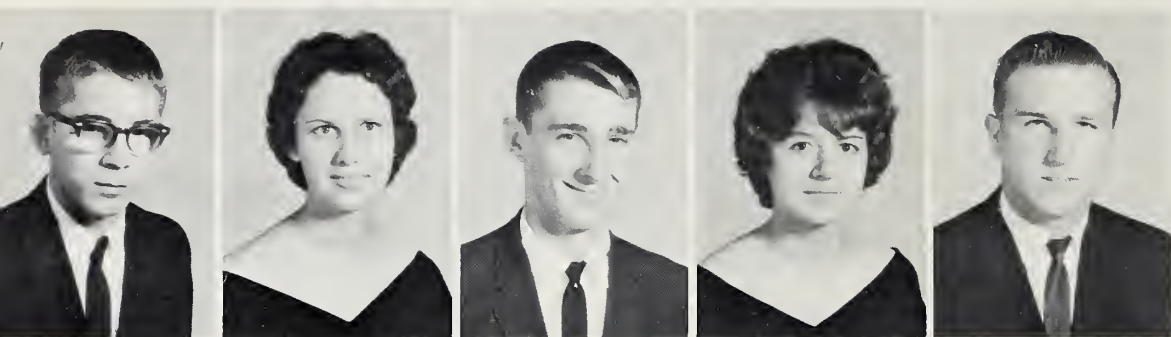

“Wishing Will Make It So”

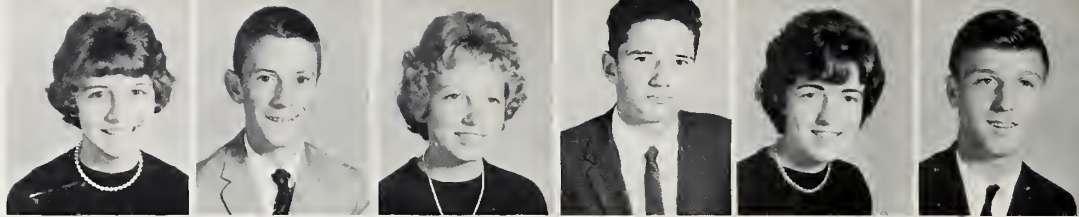

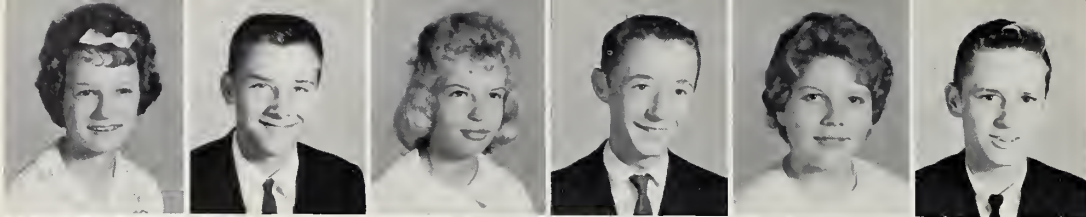
“Young At Heart”
