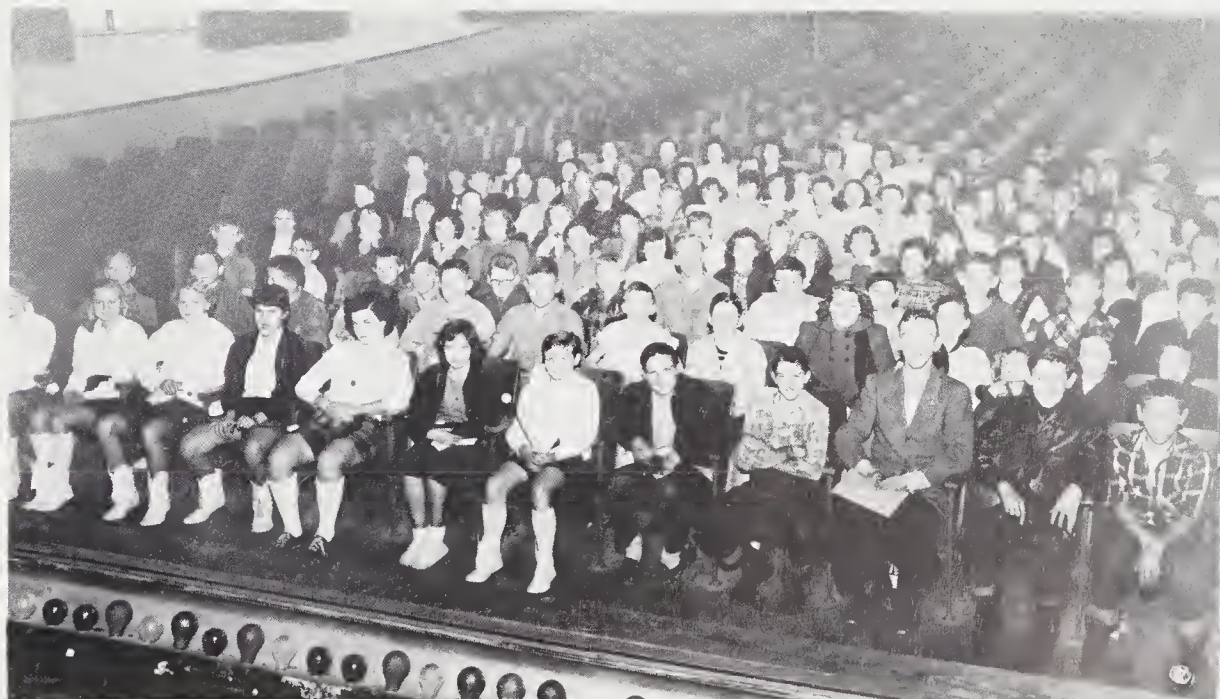
## F. F. A.

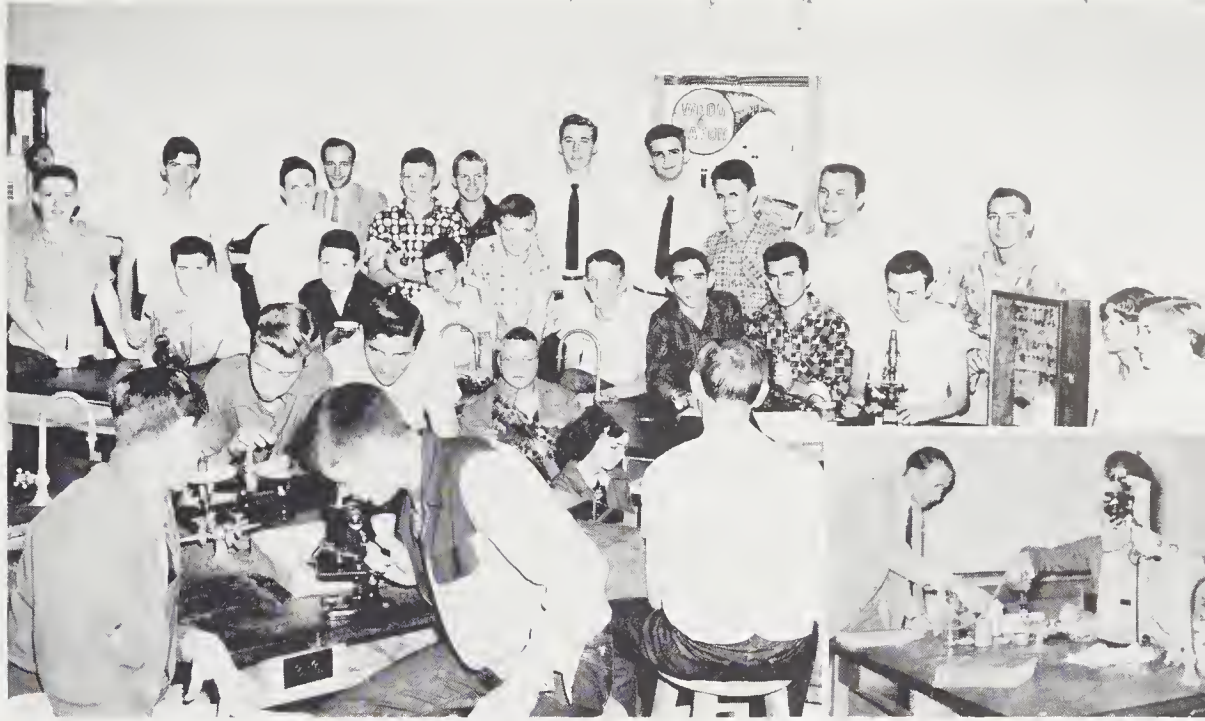


## Dramatic Club

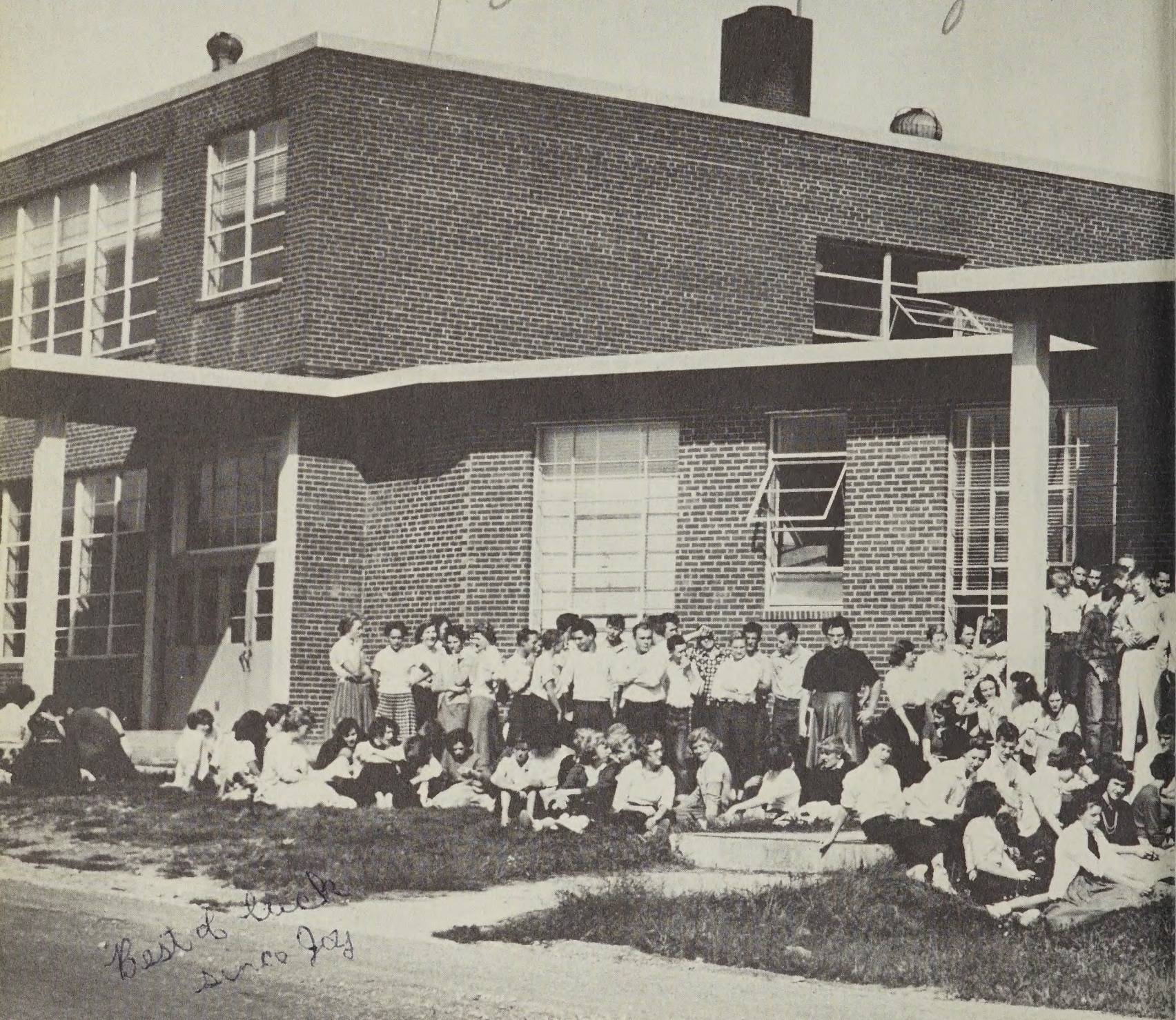


## Senior Challenge
