The prices named in this list cancel all previous quotations, and are subject to change without notice. All prices are net, boxing and bailing extra at cost, no charge for loading bulk stock. **All goods are forwarded at purchaser's risk.**

Claims for errors, deductions, etc., must be made within ten days after goods arrive at destination to receive attention.

Terms of Payment—Cash with order except where credit has been established. 6% interest on past due accounts

C. O. D. Shipments—Orders for C.O.D. shipments should be accompanied by cash for one-third of the amount of the order to insure acceptance.

Non-Warranty and Liability—We give no warranty, expressed or implied, as to the growth or productiveness of the Nursery Stock that we sell, our only guarantee being that it will be in good condition at the time that it leaves our hands. We exercise the greatest care to keep our varieties pure and true to name and hold ourselves in readiness to replace at all times, on proper proof, any Nursery Stock that may prove otherwise or to refund the amount paid, but it is mutually agreed that we shall at no time be liable for any amount greater than the amount originally paid for said Nursery Stock.

NOTE: We accept all orders subject to crop conditions and on condition that same shall be void should injury befall our stock from hail, fire, frost, error in count or other causes beyond our control. All orders are accepted for non-performance if labor shortages or delay in transportation should prevent us from making delivery.

Location and Shipping Facilities—Nurseries and office are located in the center of Indiana, 6 miles directly west Indianapolis on U. S. 40. Our Nursery is 3 miles from Indianapolis Municipal Airport.

Where customers wish to send their own trucks for bulk loading, it is advisable to give us three or four days advance notice so that we may have the material ready when the truck arrives and avoid delay.

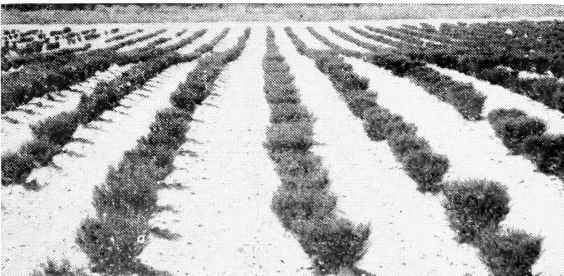
