Dealers are invited to call and examine our facilities for packing and shipping retail orders, which we are prepared to do at the lowest rates.

We take special care in filling orders, not only to have the stock fully up to grade, but as far as possible, of a uniform size and appearance.

TO CORRESPONDENTS.

We invite those who have large orders to give, or who wish to buy special varieties or sizes not enumerated in this list to write us, and promise the best terms the nature of their order and the current price of the stock will permit.

We make no charge for packing in cars.

Persons ordering are requested to give full shipping directions. Our responsibility ceases when the packages are delivered to the forwarders.

If any error should occur, claim for the same must be made immediately after the arrival of the goods in the hands of the purchaser.

We expect to conform to the wishes of our customers in the selection of varieties, and will not deviate from instructions unless by special permission.

Persons intending to order are requested to do so as early as convenient, as the period is short during which we can depend upon filling orders at wholesale rates.

We usually commence digging in the Fall by the last week in September, and in the Spring by the first week in April.

Orders for early spring shipment are dug late in the fall and carried over winter in cellar. We can thus ship at any desired date, without regard to whether the ground out of doors is open or not.
