 CONDUCTORS MUST BE NOTIFIED to stop, as Wayne is not a regular station.

SPECIAL NOTICE.

Having merged the deciduous fruit tree department of my Nursery into the "California Nursery Company," of Niles, Alameda County, I would respectfully refer any one wishing that class of stock to that establishment.

DIRECTIONS FOR SHIPPING.

Parties ordering are requested to state explicitly the mode of conveyance by which they desire their trees forwarded. When no route is designated, we forward to the best of our judgment; but in no case do we assume any responsibility after the packages are shipped, unless for our own mistakes. When losses occur by detention, claims should at once be made on the forwarders.

CONDITIONS OF SALE.

FIRST.—The articles on the following list will be furnished at the annexed prices, *only* when the quantity specified shall be taken, excepting that FIVE HUNDRED will be furnished at the THOUSAND rate, fifty at the hundred rate, and five at the ten rate. *In no case will we supply long lists of selected varieties, of either Trees or Plants, to Nurserymen or others, at wholesale rates; but at such a discount from retail single prices as circumstances will justify.* Ordinarily, a discount of from 10 to 33 $\frac{1}{4}$ per cent. will be allowed on such lists.

SECOND.—The terms of payment, cash or satisfactory security, on delivery or shipment of trees.

The prices annexed do not include packing, for which a moderate charge, covering cost, will be made; but no charge is made for the conveyance of packages from the Nursery to the Railroad Station, or Express Office in San Jose.

THIRD.—All orders to be sent by express, C. O. D., must be accompanied by one-half the amount in cash.

FOURTH.—Remittances may be sent by Draft or Post-office Order on San Jose, Wells, Fargo & Co.'s Money Order, Registered Letter, or Cash by Express, prepaid. Address all communications to
