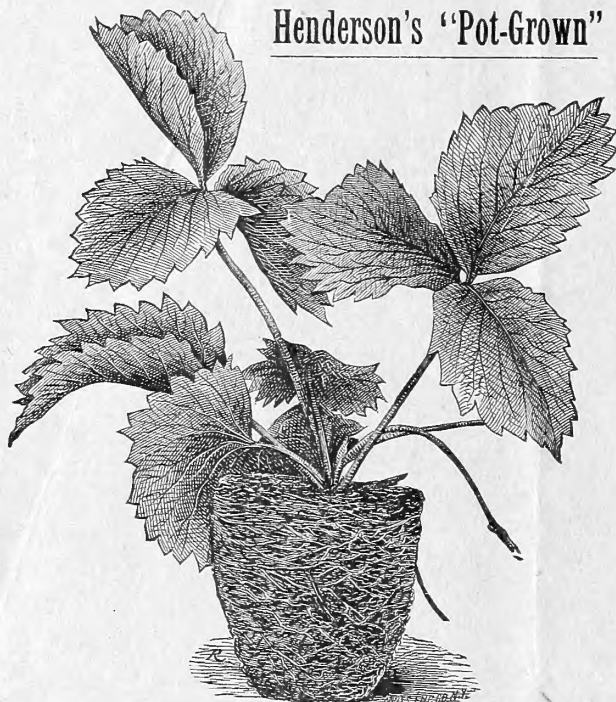

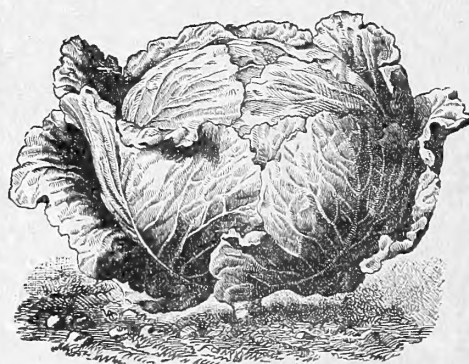
We grow our strawberry plants in pots, they are much superior to the ordinary ground layers usually sold, as there is no loss of fine roots in taking them up, and they can be shipped safely to distant parts of the United States and Canada, and be transplanted at any season, and it scarcely checks their growth; consequently, if planted before the 15th of September, they will grow into large plants and bear a full crop of berries next spring, being a clear gain of a year over "ground layers," which is certainly worth more than the slight difference in first cost.

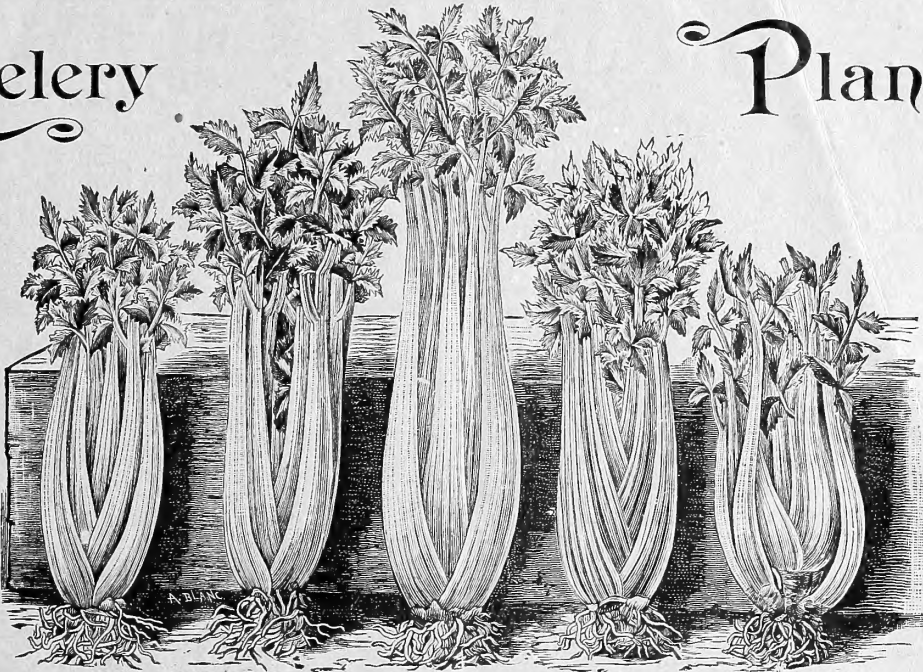

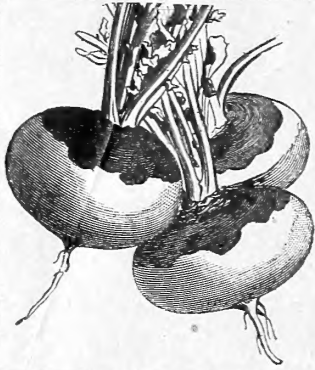

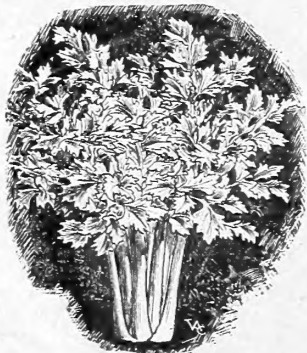
