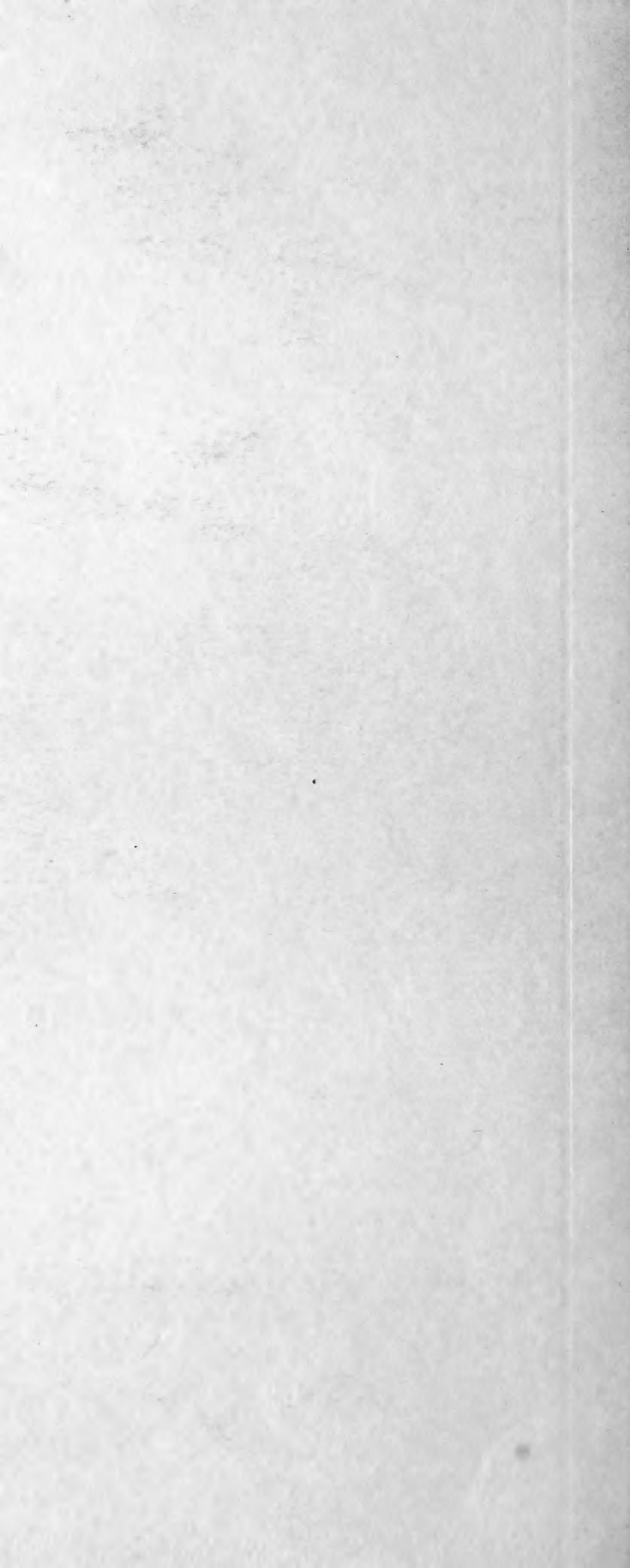

After delivering to forwarders, all articles are entirely at the risk of the purchasers, and if any loss or delay occurs the forwarders alone must be held responsible.

**CLAIMS,** if any must be made immediately upon receipt of goods, when they will be carefully examined, and if just, made satisfactory, but in no case are we responsible for more than the purchase price of the stock in question.

**TERMS.** We offer the usual terms, net 30 days from date of invoice, to those of known responsibility but must have satisfactory business references from others or cash must accompany order. Those desiring stock shipped by express C. O. D. will please remit one-quarter the amount of their purchase when ordering.

**NON-WARRANTY.** We give no warranty expressed or implied, the purchaser assuming all risk and responsibility of transportation, planting, growth life of stock or any other matter on any stock we sell. We exercise the greatest care to keep our stock true to name and are willing to replace, on proper proof, all stock that may prove otherwise, or refund the amount paid, but it is mutually agreed that we shall not at any time be liable for a greater amount than the original purchase price.
