Early Yellow Jersey and Yellow Nansemond, at market prices.

Artichokes, Red Brazilian, per peck, 75 cents; per bushel, \$1 50.  
 White French, " 75 cents; " \$1 50.

These will yield on common farm land 700 to 1,000 bushels of tubers per acre, and I find them a valuable food for cows, hogs and sheep.
