INTRODUCTORY

DURING the past season we have made every effort to keep the stock up to the high standard which has characterized all the Berckmans products, and the entire nursery has been cared for in our usual efficient fashion. We do not hesitate to say that customers who make up their orders from this price list will not be disappointed in the quality of stock which will be furnished.

PRICES.—This list cancels previous offers, and the prices quoted are net and not subject to discounts.

We reserve the right to advance prices without notice.

Orders for less than 400 trees or plants of a class will be billed at 100 rate; when 400 are ordered, prices will be at rate per 1,000; 40 at 100 rate; 5 at 10 rate.

In no case will long lists of selected varieties be supplied, two or three of either fruit or ornamental trees or plants, etc., to nurserymen or dealers at wholesale rates but a discount of 25 per cent from retail single prices is allowed on such lists.

Packing charges at cost.

TERMS OF PAYMENT.—Cash with order, or satisfactory reference before shipment; or, if preferred, will ship goods with bill of lading attached to sight draft, through express or bank. On all C. O. D. orders we require 25 per cent. of the bill remitted before shipment.

All quotations are for immediate acceptance, subject to stock being sold. No liability to attach to us where frost, drought or other casualties beyond our control prevent delivery of stock that may be contracted for.

Claims.—All claims for errors must be made upon receipt of goods. Should any error occur at any time, we desire to be informed at once, in order to rectify same without delay.

When ordering, please give plain and explicit directions as to route and manner in which goods are to be forwarded. Give name of express office or railroad which you prefer. When routing is left to our judgment, we will select the best route, but in no case will we assume responsibility for safe delivery of goods after proper shipment by us. All goods travel at purchaser's risk. Claims for delay, or loss must be made on the carrier.

We are in a position to make prompt shipments, and have every reason to believe that goods will travel rapidly after being transferred to the express or railroad carriers, and after looking through this folder you will feel that we are justified in soliciting your patronage this year, and assure you that both stock and service will be on the same high plane that the Berckmans conducted the business heretofore.
