All claims for errors and deductions must be made within six days after receipt of stock.

Our Guarantee of Genuineness.—While we exercise the greatest diligence and care to have all our trees, etc., true to label, and hold ourselves in readiness, on proper proof, to replace all trees, etc., that may prove untrue to label, free of charge, or refund the amount paid, it is mutually understood and agreed between the purchaser and ourselves that our guarantee of genuineness shall in no case make us liable for any sum greater than originally received for said trees, etc., that prove untrue.

All Fruit Trees and Grapevines are fumigated with hydrocyanic gas when dug, so are the buds, scions, and cuttings, prior to budding, grafting, or planting out in Nursery. This positively kills any insects that may be thereon, without any injury to tree or vines. We have erected on our grounds a new Fumigating House, with three compartments, so that we can disinfect, at any time, either 50 trees or 10,000.
