New and Rare Bulbs, Plants and Seeds

AMARYLLIS. Hybrid seedlings for spring blooming, from Defiance, Oriflame and Vitata. White, elegantly lined and striped with scarlet and maroon. Some shaded with yellow and cream Red, striped with white, and beautifully penciled with scarlet and maroon. Petals fluted and recurved. Some flowers have seven or eight petals. Very beautiful. Large strong bulbs, 50c each, \$4.25 to \$5.50 per doz., assorted, post paid; \$30 per hundred.

CANNA. Ehemanni Guttermanni. European novelty, seedling from Ehemanni, of the same habit and height. Splendid foliage. Long stems, crowned with immense clusters of large, drooping, Fuschsia-like flowers of a lovely, rich, salmon-pink. Flowers same size as Ehemanni, but keep better. A grand Canna. 50c each, \$5 doz. Supply limited.

Variegata. Very pretty dwarf variety, with light green foliage, beautifully variegated with yellow. Very showy and rare. 10c.
