




VITALITY OF SEEDS

The following schedule gives the length of time that seeds will grow freely. It is true that some varieties will even keep longer than the period mentioned, but their strength will be greatly impaired. Parsley and Corn Salad will grow more freely the second year than the first; and Cucumbers, Melons and Squashes produce larger crops from seeds two years old than from the new, from the fact that they make less growth of vine and set their blossoms

Seeds of all kinds should be kept in a dry situation, and in sacks in preference to barrels.



A Field of Ely's Early Jersey Wakefield Cabbage. (Photograph.)





MUSHROOM SPAWN



Mushrooms can be readily grown in cellars, stables, sheds or pits,

Many are successfully grown on a shelf in an ordinary cellar and yield sufficient crops to compensate the grower for his effort. Spent hotbeds also meet the requirements of the mushroom in a large measure. Bits of spawn can be inserted before the bed has become cold between the plants. When the plants are removed, keep

shaded with long litter, and water occasionally if necessary. The space under greenhouse benches or stagings will suit them exactly, using materials in same manner as described. They will also grow admirably on top of the bench, as shown in the illustration, using cloth for shading instead of litter. The time required for a bed to come into bearing is three to six weeks.





• "Z. DeFOREST ELY is the youngest son of the Rev. Ezra Stiles Ely, D. D., of Philadelphia, and was born in the house (831 N. Seventh street, Philadelphia), which he now owns and in which he still resides; his mother was Caroline T. Holmes, the daughter of Thompson Holmes, M. D., of "Parsalia," Accomack Co., Virginia; his great-grand-mother was a Miss DeForest, of an old Huguenot French family, and from her his middle name is derived.

Rev. Ezra Stiles Ely, D. D., was born in June, 1786, in Connecticut; his father was the Rev. Zebulon Ely, D. D., born in Lyme, Conn., February 5, 1759, and who married Sarah Aparm Mills. Rev. Zebulon Ely was the Pastor of the First Church in Lebanon, Conn., graduated at Yale College, November 18, 1782; he was the son of the Rev. Ezra Ely, born January, 1728, who married Sarah Sterling, and lived at Lyme, Conn.





This Rev. Ezra Ely was the son of Rev. Richard Ely, born October, 1697, who also lived at Lyme, Conn., and had two wives, Elizabeth Peck and Phœbe Hubbard.

Rev. Richard Ely, 3d (the father of Rev. Ezra Ely), was the son of Richard Ely, 2d, who also lived in Lyme, and married Mary Marvin; his father was Richard Ely, 1st, who came from Plymouth, England, in the county of Devonshire, in the year 1660; he came to Lyme and settled on the banks of the Connecticut River about seven miles from its mouth. He married the daughter of Col. Fenwick, of Boston, who owned the great meadows now known as the "Ely Meadows."

In the midst of an active business life Z. DeFOREST ELY has found time to devote attention to fraternal organizations. He is a life member and Past Master of Lodge No. 51, F. & A. 
