The J.F. Webb Wildcats had a very successful football season, settling for a third place tie with Roxboro. The 'Cats were in the battle for the loop crown up to the final game, when they bowed to Roxboro, 23-7. While compiling their 6-4 record, the Wildcats had a 5-0 home slate, bringing their two-year home record to 8-1-1, second best in the District. Being led by co-captains Marty Yancey and David Cannady, the Wildcats beat Wakelon (26-12), co-champion Chapel Hill (8-7), Orange (25-7), Southern (13-0), Jordan (40-7), and Henderson (25-7), while losing only to co-champion Northern (20-29), Dunn (7-13), Henderson (7-19), and Roxboro.
