Chlorine Chloride

It is a colorless gas, with a strong
pungent odor, and is heavier than
air. It is formed by the action of
manganese dioxide on hydrochloric
acid, and passes over water
still in solution. It is also
formed by the action of sulfuric
acid on the chloride of sodium
in the absence of the water, and
is then called the anhydrous
chlorine. It is a powerful
oxidizing agent, and is used
in the manufacture of
bleaching powder, and in
the preparation of
chlorine water. It is also
