My hope is that all of our students who return to school will use every talent that God has given them to become the finest kind of person.

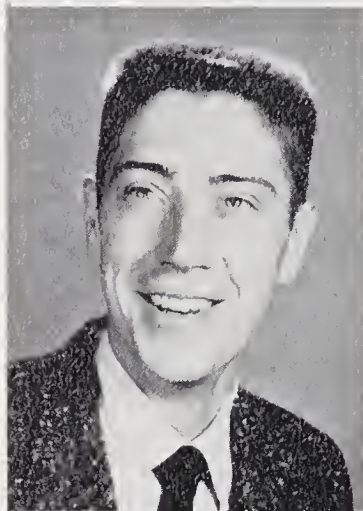
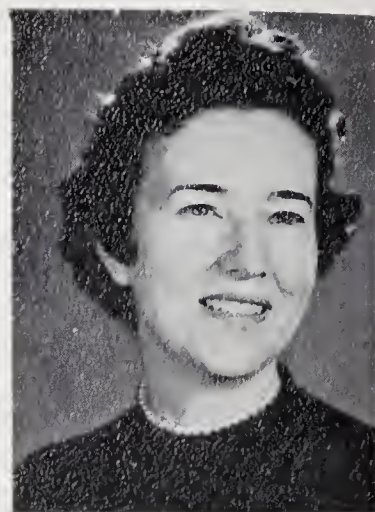
