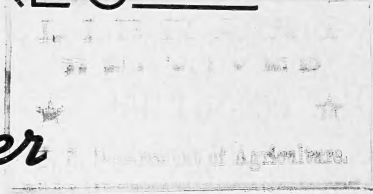

**BROKEN LOTS** of less than 10 of any one variety and grade will be billed at 15% above 10 rates.

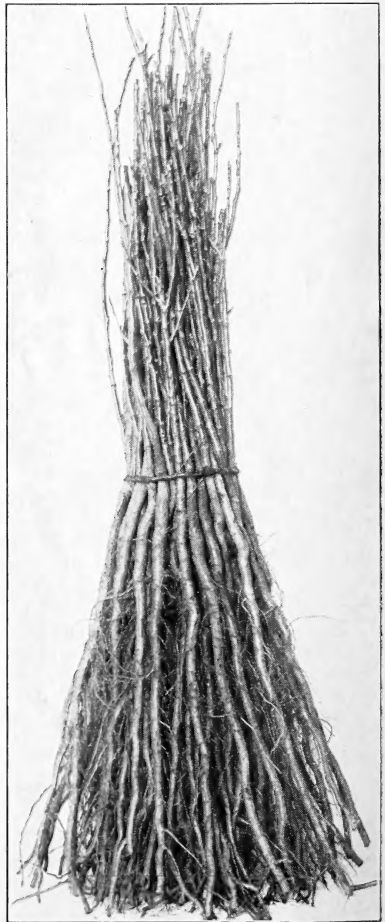

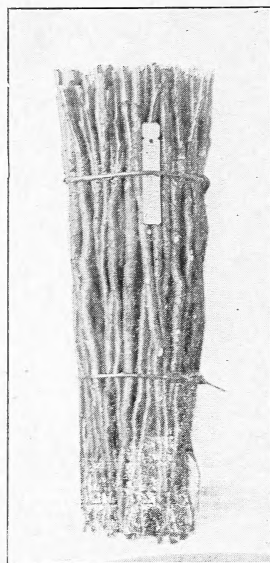

**Marigold.** Early semi-cling, tender, flesh excellent flavor. Fruit ripens the first ten days of August.

**Mikado.** Most popular early yellow, medium sized tree, vigorous and productive. Fruit ripens first week in August. Medium size, round, semi-cling, attractive yellow of good quality.

**Oriole.** Attractive, medium sized, rounded yellow fruit. Good quality freestone. Vigorous; fruit ripens middle of August.

**Valiant.** Promising seedling of Elberta. Productive; large, yellow blushed with red, firm, juicy and good quality freestone. Ripens two weeks before Elberta.

**Vedette.** Elberta seedling ripening three weeks earlier and of superior quality and color; fruit large, yellow; freestone.

**Polly.** Exceptionally hardy, vigorous, productive. Fruit large; freestone; juicy, white, firm flesh. Ripens week before Elberta.

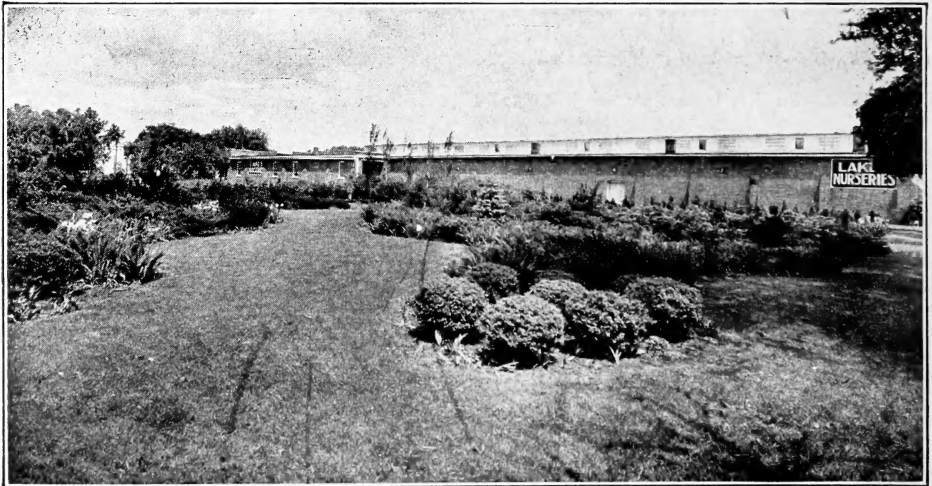
